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Overview and Pre-requisites

You have been asked to install SDL MultiTerm 2011 in order to perform terminology lookup and access termbase(s) on ETMA with a read-only access.

This document provides you the step-by-step procedure to perform this task.



<u>NOTE</u>: In order to download the SDL MultiTerm installation package, you will need an access to ETMA. If you do not yet have an account on ETMA, please contact the ETMA Service Desk:

Download SDL MultiTerm 2011 software

The SDL MultiTerm 2011 installation package is available for you to download on ETMA:

- 1. Go to http://www.hp.com/etma, and enter your ETMA username and password
- 2. On the Home tab, click My Downloads menu on the navigation bar.



3. Under **System Downloads**, select "SDLMultiTermDesktop2011_SP2_361.exe" and save this file to your disk.



Install SDL MultiTerm 2011 Desktop

The installation routine for MultiTerm Desktop is based on an installation wizard that guides you through the setup process.

To install MultiTerm Desktop:

- 1. Double–click on the downloaded .exe file and click **Run**. This will start the installation wizard.
- 2. Accept: This is the first page in the MultiTerm Desktop installation wizard. Click Accept to continue.
- 3. License Agreement: Read through the contents of the license agreement and select to accept the terms of the agreement. Click Next to continue.
- 4. **Component Selection**: This page lists the individual features that are available for installation on MultiTerm Desktop. Deselect any features that you wish to exclude from your installation.
