

Terminology Management – Overview

What is this all about?

Terminology Management is not only about translation...


<u>Term definition</u>: spelling and definition in a given language



monitor.

<u>Term usage</u>: attributes to define context and domain

<u>Term translation</u>: agreed translation of a term in another language






Terminology in Master Content Quality




... and multiply that by the # of languages your business translates into!

Terminology Management – Program Opportunities

Global Brand Terminology management is essential to speak to all customers, in any language, with a consistent voice.

Terminology matters, because our Brand matters...

Consolidate

Brand, global marketing or business team add the new tagline or concept to the HP Terminology Community or send it to terminology@hp.com



Approve

Subject matter expert in the BU or community member in the HP Terminology Community, propose, comment and vote on relevant translation



Reuse & Maintain

The "winning" translation is added to <u>HP termbases</u> (HP terminology repository) and available for lookup and reuse.





Translator View


Terminology information is pushed to vendors during translation
